Initial Considerations

How does a usual project look like?

- EU added value.
- Usually, it will require a **consortium** involving, at least, 3 legal entities in 3 different Member States or Associated Countries.
- Aligned with the specific R&D lines included in the calls and relevant work programmes (topics).
- Comply with ethical principles, and with national/EU legislation.



Initial Considerations

Am I ready for participation?

- Does the participation opportunity fits my **strategy**?
- Collaboration with **international partners**:
 - Do I like it?
 - Do I have them? Can I find them?
- Calls have particular characteristics:
 - **Extremely competitive** - ready to be disappointed?
 - Is the usual time to grant ok for me?
- Do I have the right team to write the application?



Key Milestones

- Definition of a clear/concise project idea
- Search for potential funding opportunities
- Validation of the project idea: Go/No Go decision
- Proposal preparation
 - Consortium building
 - Application writing
- Support available: your EU office, NCP network, EU funded initiatives, etc.



Benefits from participation

- Cooperation with key stakeholders/researchers on a given area
- Training for own staff
- Access to new technologies
- Access to new markets
- International reputation
- Funding for R&D activities



H2020: resumo

- Programa de financiamento para investigación e innovación – case **80 mil millóns de euros** (2014 - 2020).
- Novo Programa Cadro (FP), que agrupa tres programas/iniciativas (FP, EIT, CIP).
- Continuación do apoio á **investigación** de calidade.
- Máis apoio para actividades de **innovación** – creación de **oportunidades de negocio**.
- **Simplificación** dos procesos e redución dos tempos (5 meses para resolución + 3 meses para preparación acordo subvención)



H2020: resumo

- **Novo regulamento de participación** más homoxéneo, coherente con outros programas da UE.
- **Un proxecto – unha porcentaxe** de financiamento.
 - Custos elixibles: directos + indirectos (25% dos custos directos).
 - Financiamento 100% para proxectos de investigación;
 - Financiamento 70 % para accións de innovación (100 % para entidades sen ánimo de lucro).
- Interese da **cooperación internacional**.
- **Criterios de avaliación**: Excelencia, Impacto, Implementación. Máximo 5 puntos por criterio.


